- ◆ The 2024 Republican platform does <u>not</u> mention Ukraine. Previous platforms included a pledge of support for Ukraine's sovereignty and a commitment to assistance in its defense. (<u>The Republican Party Platform</u>, 2024 Ballotpedia)
- ◆ Donald Trump "will not give a penny" to Ukraine if he is re-elected, the farright Hungarian prime minister, Viktor Orbán, said after meeting with Trump in Florida. (The Guardian, 3/11/24)
- ◆ J.D. Vance is a vocal opponent of aid for Ukraine. "I don't really care what happens to Ukraine one way or the other," he said, and tried to block a \$60 billion aid package in the Senate. (NY Times 7/15/24) He also proposed that Ukraine give up its territory to end the war. (NBC News, 12/11/23)
- ◆ Trump said that Russia could do "whatever the hell they want" to any NATO country in a stunning admission he would not abide by the collectivedefense clause at the heart of the alliance if reelected. (CNN, 2/11/2024)
- Trump praised Putin's invasion of Ukraine as "genius" and "savvy."

- Trump was impeached for attempting to extort Ukraine. Trump held up an aid package of \$391 million and pressured President Zelensky to open a fraudulent investigation into Trump's political opponents, leading to his first impeachment.
- Nearly two-thirds of aid to Ukraine goes to US factories spread out across the country, including plants in Ohio and Pennsylvania.
