

VOTE BY MAIL

Every registered voter in Pennsylvania can vote by mail! No excuse needed. Voting by mail is safe, secure, and convenient. Just follow these three easy steps:

1. Request the Ballot

The deadline to request a mail-in ballot is 5 PM on Tuesday October 29, 2024. You should do it as soon as possible to avoid delays!

OPTION A: REQUEST A BALLOT ONLINE

· Request a mail ballot online through our website at padems.org/mail

OPTION B: REQUEST A BALLOT THROUGH THE MAIL

- Download the paper application from vote.pa.gov
- · Complete the form and return it by mail to your county election office

OPTION C: APPLY AT YOUR COUNTY ELECTION OFFICE

 Complete the paper application form at your county election office or satellite voting location

2. Complete the Ballot

- Read the instructions carefully!
- Complete your ballot using black or blue ink
- Place your completed ballot in the yellow envelope that says "Official Election Ballot" and seal it
 - Do not put any kind of marking on the yellow envelope
- Place the yellow envelope in the return envelope and seal it
- ☑ Sign your name in the appropriate box and write the full month, day, & year

3. Return the Ballot

Return your ballot to your county election office before 8 PM on Tuesday, November 5. You can return your ballot either:

OPTION A: IN-PERSON

· Bring your ballot to your county election office, a ballot drop box, or satellite election office

OPTION B: BY MAIL

- Mail the ballot to your County Board of Elections.
- · They must receive it by 8 PM on Election Day, Tuesday November 5
- · If returning by mail, we recommend that you send it no later than Monday, October 28
